Milton Keynes is the UK's prime office location for companies seeking superb connectivity to London, UK and international markets, workforce excellence and a significantly reduced cost base.

Located just 32 minutes from London, the city's highly developed industry cluster includes more than 400 head office and financial services companies, and a specialist workforce of more than 22,000 people.

Milton Keynes is ideally positioned to support business growth. Property solutions include available prime office premises and unique, city centre greenfield development sites. The city's fast growing population and housing stock further support business expansions.

But Milton Keynes offers something more: significant savings on property and labour costs versus competitor UK locations, including -72% lower prime office rents than London.

MK Transport and Data Connectivity

Transport Connectivity

Milton Keynes' strategic location and excellent transport connectivity have been key factors in attracting major head office, and 'business, professional and financial services' operations to the city.

While benefiting from the reduced costs and congestion of an out-of-London location, businesses located in Milton Keynes can access central London in just 32 minutes (by rail)^[6]. That makes the city an extension of 'Europe's business capital', while enabling faster access to other UK business centres than can be achieved from a London base.

Milton Keynes benefits from significantly better international connectivity than the UK's major provincial cities. Fast, direct access to the London airports system, as well as Birmingham airport, means that Milton Keynes-based business travellers can access more than 400 direct and hub-feeder air services in less than 1 hour.^{[14] [15] [16]}

Data Connectivity

Milton Keynes also provides businesses with high-quality data connectivity. The entire county of Buckinghamshire (including MK) achieves an overall Ofcom ranking of '1' (highest/fastest) for broadband coverage, based on 4 key metrics:

- Average broadband take-up
- Percentage receiving less than 2Mbit/s
- Superfast broadband availability
- Average modem sync speed^[18]

Additionally, the city's 'Central Superfast Broadband Project' delivers superfast broadband access (24 Mbps) to 96% of MK premises.^[19]

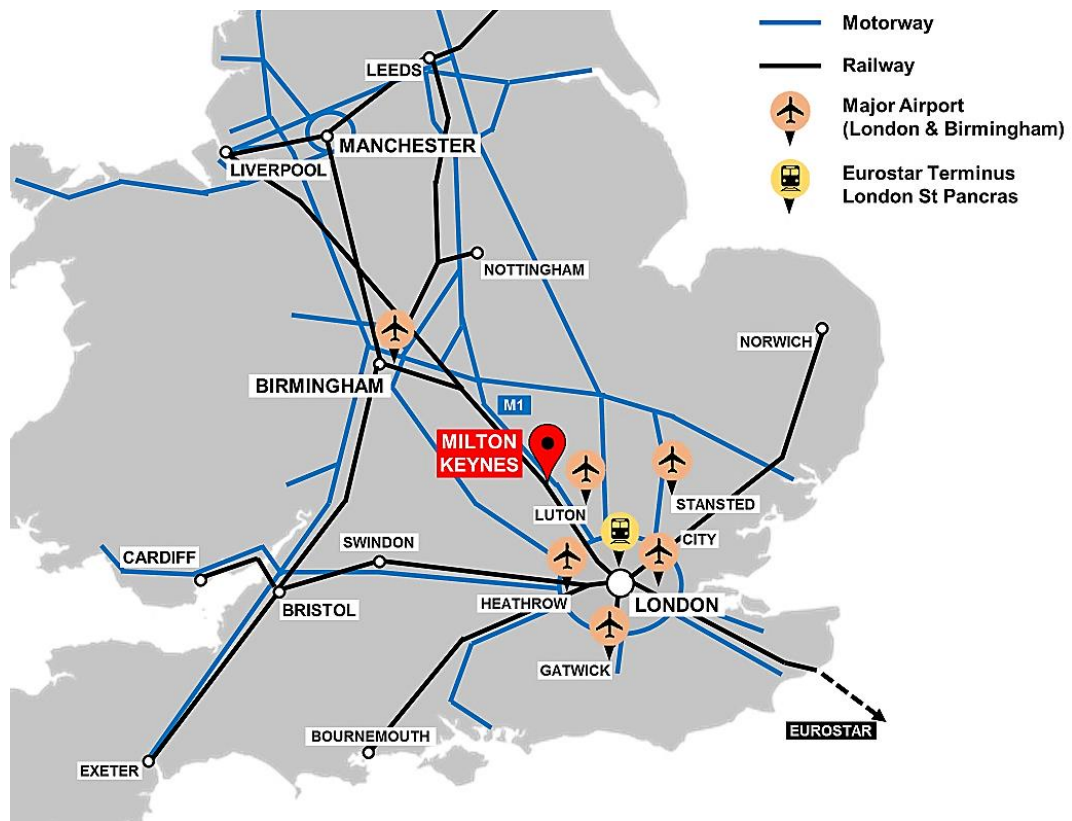
